

# Supports and Services for Living on Campus: **SUCCEED**



## Living

### *Where do I live?*

- Option to live on campus for the duration of the 2-year program
- Dorm rooms located in Oak Hall
  - Suite-style living with a shared bathroom
  - Up to four individuals in a room

### *Who do I live with?*

- Depending on the number and gender of Succeed students enrolled in a cohort, students live with several other roommates
- Roommates may or may not be enrolled in the Succeed program

### *Who supports students living on campus?*

- Supports provided by the Succeed program staff are individualized to support student-specific needs
- Residential Advisors (RA) are available to all students living in Oak Hall
  - RA can support with suitemate mediations, laundry, and any other support in the dorms
- Succeed students will continue to have access to existing county and/or VR supports related to independent living
