

Supports and Services for Learning on Campus: **SUCCEED**



Structure

What is the overall course structure?

- Succeed is a two-year-long program consisting of four academic semesters.
- Succeed students take 12-15 credit hours per semester consisting of a combination of certificate courses and electives related to their academic goals.

Courses

What types of courses are required of SUCCEED students?

- Succeed students take certificate courses in areas focused on:
 - Healthy Relationships
 - Vocational Exploration and Preparation
 - Self and Civic Responsibilities
 - Social Networking and Advocacy
- Students are enrolled in a vocational course every semester. In addition to their course, they will have a vocational lab in which they receive small group support and instruction to work towards their individualized work goals.

Unrequired Courses

What other courses from the university catalog can SUCCEED students take?

- Succeed students have access to the entire UMSL course catalog during their second year.
- There are opportunities for students to enroll in modified credit courses in order to meet their academic goals. Modified courses allow for the student to take a modified version of the course for 1 credit. Modified courses provide more flexibility in how the student participates in the course.

Certificates

What type of credential, certificate, or degree do students earn upon completing the program?

- Succeed students graduate with a Chancellor's Certificate.

Support

What supports do SUCCEED students receive related to their academic coursework?

- Succeed students are provided with a holistic coach who meets with students weekly to support their success in each of the four pillars: Live, Learn, Work, and Play.
- Holistic coaches support students in managing their time, adjusting to living in residential housing, applying for jobs, and more!
- Students also will receive academic tutoring to help them complete course assignments.
- Succeed students are scheduled to meet with their coaches and tutors at least once a week.
- Succeed may apply to receive accommodations and support from the UMSL Disability Access Services.
- Succeed students may also utilize services from UMSL Career Services.
