Academic Programs and Supports: SUCCEED



Structure

What is the overall course structure?

- Succeed is a 2-year, 4-semester program that is housed at the University of Missouri St. Louis (UMSL). The Succeed program is four academic semesters.
- Succeed students take 12-15 credit hours per semester consisting of a combination of certificate courses and electives related to their academic goals.

Courses

What types of courses are required of Succeed students?

- Succeed students take certificate courses in areas focused on:
 - Healthy Relationships
 - Vocational Exploration and Preparation
 - Self and Civic Responsibilities
 - Social Networking and Advocacy
- Students are enrolled in a vocational course every semester.
 Students also participate in a vocational lab in which they receive small group support and instruction to work towards their individualized work goals.

What other courses from the university catalog can Succeed students take?

- Succeed students have access to the entire UMSL course catalog.
- There are opportunities for students to enroll in modified credit courses to meet their academic goals.
- Modified courses allow students to take a modified version of the course for 1 credit, providing more flexibility in how they participate in the course.



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Completion

What type of credential, certificate, or degree do students earn upon completing the program?

• Succeed students graduate with a Chancellor's Certificate.

Supports

What supports do Succeed students receive related to their academic coursework?

- Succeed students are provided with a holistic coach who meets with students weekly to support their success in each of the four pillars: Live, Learn, Work, and Play.
- Holistic coaches support students in managing their time, adjusting to living in residential housing, applying for jobs, and more!
- Students can also receive academic tutoring to help them complete course assignments.
- Succeed students are scheduled to meet with their coaches and tutors at least once a week.
- Succeed may apply to receive accommodations and support from the <u>UMSL Disability Access Services</u>. Students can also utilize services from <u>UMSL Career Services</u>.
