## Living

#### Where do I live?

- Students in the Succeed program at the University of Missouri St. Louis (UMSL) have the option to live on campus for the duration of the 2-year program.
- Dorm rooms are located in Oak Hall and offer suite-style living with a shared bathroom and up to four students in a room.
- Succeed students also have the option to commute to UMSL.

#### Who do I live with?

- Depending on the number and gender of Succeed students enrolled in a cohort, students live with several other roommates.
- Roommates may or may not be enrolled in the Succeed program.

## Who supports students living on campus?

- Supports are individualized to support student-specific needs.
- Resident Advisors (RAs) are available to all students living in Oak Hall.
  - RAs can assist with suitemate mediations, laundry, and any other support in the dorms.
- Succeed students will continue to have access to existing county and/or Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) supports related to independent living.

## Safety

### How do I stay safe?

- Succeed students have access to all public/university safety resources including the UMSL Police Department.
- Succeed students also take a Healthy Relationships Class that focuses on topics related to harm reduction, boundary setting, and relationship building with peers and coworkers.

## **Transportation**

### How do I get around campus?

- UMSL offers a <u>shuttle service</u> that runs seven days a week during class sessions. Routes vary throughout the academic year and during breaks.
- Students can also walk, roll, drive, or use Uber/Taxis to get around campus.

## **Dining**

#### Where do I eat?

- There are a number of dining options around campus.
- Students living on campus are required to have a meal plan and can use their Triton ID to purchase meals using their meal plan (see <a href="https://www.umsl.edu/services/reslife/current-residents/meal-plans.html">https://www.umsl.edu/services/reslife/current-residents/meal-plans.html</a> for more information).
- Students can choose from a variety of dining options at the Nosh.
